Program / Project Description:

Creating interventions and/or strategies will increase the number of adolescent and teenage girls graduating without experiencing an unplanned pregnancy during high school and not being pregnant when they graduate high school. Also to help decrease STIs. Targeted group and beneficiaries are students in Nash/Edgecombe County, North Carolina high schools in grades 9 to 12. The number of students that will be assisted will be approximately 160 students that transition in and out of the sex education class (entitled Healthy Living) within a traditional school year. Our program will administer sexual risk avoidance education that will empower participants to make healthy decisions and teach the holistic, individual, and societal benefits associated with personal responsibility, self- regulation, goal setting, healthy decision-making, and a focus on the future.

Evaluation Plan:

A viable method that will be used to determine if our mentoring program project outcomes are being achieved are comparisons throughout the implementation of the program with participants high school youth risk behavior entrance and exit surveys, satisfaction surveys, and fidelity rating instruments. This data collected will be used to engage in continuous quality improvements in our program. We will be partnering with educators in the Nash and Edgecombe County High Schools also parents and leaders in the community.

Plans to sustain project beyond the term of this request:

Our current board members will continue to sustain 100% of the cost. We have operated on a small scale over the years.
